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Tournament Application Guidelines

When dealing with Second Level or Third Level players, host clubs must liaise with the relevant education body & Comhairle Uladh in respect of tournament schedule prior to submitting tournament programme to Comhairle Uladh.

Tournament Name should be provided for approval by Comhairle Uladh. The word 'Tournament' shall be used and any words that suggest an official Comhairle Uladh competition (e.g. 'Ulster' or Championship') shall not be used. This also applies to promotional material.

Comhairle Uladh may require hosts to attend meeting of CCC.

Application should have County Secretary signature, include fee and identify the purpose of the Tournament. This should be submitted to Comhairle Uladh 30 days prior to the tournament commencing.

First Aid cover must be provided by the host club.

All Tournaments (Except one day blitzes) to be 'knock-out' based (no 'round-robin' formats).

Tournaments must be completed within a calendar month (max. five weekends). Any amendments to schedule must be approved by CU (e.g. postponements, replays). Extra-time to be played in event of draw in all games (including final).

No club participating in a tournament may 'withdraw' players from a College, Post Primary or Third Level team participating in another authorised competition.

Application for all post 16 years of age tournaments should only include referees on a current Ulster Referees panel. These tournaments must abide by regulations governing the organization and presentation of inter-club championships. All other tournaments must be refereed by qualified match referees.

Penalties For breach of Tournament Regulations:

For organising an unauthorised Tournament: County €1,000 fine Club €500 fine & liable to a minimum 8 week suspension – Rule 6.38. T.O.2014.

For participation in an unauthorised Tournament: County €500 fine Club €250 fine; Team/Player liable to minimum suspension of 8 weeks – Rule 6.38. 2014.

Host Club/Unit – debarment from hosting any tournament for a minimum of 96 weeks Participant (Counties & Clubs) – debarment from participating in any tournament for a minimum of 48 weeks.
