



Gaeilge sa Chlub 2019/20: Rules and Regulations

1. This scheme is open to current GAA members within the province of Ulster.
2. All applications to Gaeilge sa Chlub must be signed by the current club secretary or chairperson.
3. Successful applicants must be willing to undertake an Irish Language Project within their local GAA Club after 6 months study and submit a short report to Ulster GAA.
4. Guidance and training in relation to the aforementioned Irish Language Project will be provided by Ulster GAA's Irish Language Officer. Attendance at this training is compulsory. Every effort is made to ensure this guidance is provided during class time. Ulster GAA may also carry out club visits to ensure these projects take place.
5. Applications are made directly to Ulster GAA, through Irish Language Officer Tricia Ní Chearra at tricia.nichearra.ulster@gaa.ie or on 07825855700.
6. Applicants to Gaeilge sa Chlub must first apply directly to the university in question in order to gain a place on the Diploma in Irish Language course. You can apply online at ulster.ac.uk/apply/how-to-apply#ug. Alternatively, you can contact the School Secretary, Caragh McCloskey: c.mccloskey@ulster.ac.uk or call 028 71675193.
7. Only registered students can access this funding. Ulster University centres of learning are located in Belfast (York St), Cookstown (Burnavon), and on the Magee campus, Derry.
8. Successful applicants to Gaeilge sa Chlub will receive a contribution to their course fee. No payment is received by individual applicants
9. Students must pay the rest of the fee directly to the University at time of registration (19th September deadline) in order to validate their scholarship.
10. Scholarships are issued on a first come, first served basis. Only applications received by the deadline will be eligible for funding.
11. Comhairle Uladh may request applicants to attend a short interview before scholarships are granted.





Gaeilge sa Chlub 2019/20: Rialacha na Scéime

1. Is féidir le baill an CLG i gCúige Uladh cuir isteach ar an scéim seo.
2. Caithfidh gach iarratas bheith sínithe ag rúnaí nó ag cathaoirleach an chlub.
3. Tá ar iarratasóirí bheith sásta tionscadal Gaeilge a eagrú ina gclubanna féin i ndiaidh dóibh 6 mhí den staidéar a dhéanamh ar an chúrsa. Scríobhann na mic léinn tuairisc ghairid ar an tionscadal.
4. Cuirfear traenáil agus cuidiú ar fáil d'iarratasóirí maidir leis an tionscadal. Tá ar an iarratasóir freastal ar sheisiúin ar bith a eagraíonn Comhairle Uladh ar a son. Tá seans ann go rachaidh CLG Uladh amach chuig clubanna chun na tionscadail seo a fheiceáil.

6. Caithfidh iarratasóirí cuir isteach ar an Diplóma tríd chóras na hOllscoile chun áit a fháil ar an chúrsa: ulster.ac.uk/apply/how-to-apply#ug. Nó, thig dul i dteagmháil le Rúnaí na Scoile, Caragh McCloskey: c.mccloskey@ulster.ac.uk nó ar 02871675193.
7. Ní féidir ach le mic léinn atá cláraithe an deontas seo a fháil. Tá an Diplóma á teagasc i mBéal Feirste (Sráid Eabhraic) ar an Chor Chríochach (Ionad Burnavon) agus ar Champas Mhig Aoidh (Doire).
8. Gheobhaidh iarratasóir ar bith a fhaigheann an scoláireacht airgead i dtreo tháillí an chúrsa. Téann an t-airgead seo go díreach chun na hollscoile.
9. Caithfidh mic léinn an chuid eile de na táillí a íoc chuig an Ollscoil féin ag am an chláráithe (spriocdháta: 19ú Meán Fómhair) le cinntiú go bhfaightear an scoláireacht.
10. Ní ghlacfar le hiarratas ar bith a thagann isteach i ndiaidh an spriocdháta.
11. Tá sé de cheart ag Comhairle Uladh iarr ar iarratasóirí dul faoi agallamh gairid sula dtabharfar scoláireachtaí amach.
