- 2) To assist the Committee in making an informed appraisal of the future viability of the Club in terms of:
 - a. Population base;
 - b. Primary school(s) enrolment(s);
 - c. Capacity for fundraising.

- 3) To assist the Committee in making an informed judgement of the real needs of the Club in terms of:
 - a. Existing facilities, indoor and outdoor;
 - b. Priority needs in short and medium terms;
 - c. The thinking of the Club re. Facilities strategic planning.

A fully completed Club Profile Form will help the Committee to:

- 1) Assess the present strength of the Club;
- 2) Appraise the future viability of the Club;
- 3) Make an informed judgement on the priority needs of the Club.
