What the system can do?

Modular approach, based on recruiting and developing coaches:

- Profile coaches
- Searches
- Email / SMS
- Managing MSD
- Capture training needs
- News feed
- Event and course booking
- Job application
- Affiliates (multiple partners using the same system)
- Collects data on coaches and participation data

Benefits to the coach:

- Develop your coaching CV
- Instant access to info / dev opps
- Job opportunities
- Support service tailored to you
- Access to training / funding

Benefits to the Employer

- Simple access to quality coaches
- Information / updates relevant to you and your coaches
- Matching the right coach to the right environment

Benefits to the NGB / CSP

- Intelligence
- Real time data on active coaches
- Consistency / problem solving
- Profiling of coaches

Establishing Coaching Northants

- Northants Sport Executive Board
- Coach Steering Group
- Coach Network
- Professional staff including CDM, CDO
Coach Admin, 2xMS coaches, 72xcasual
coaches

Sustainability

- Expenditure - £146.5k
- Income - £166k
 - » Income generation
 - » Coaching Objective Lottery Funding
 - » CSCS grant
 - » Course Income

Key Achievements

- 910 coaches registered
- 74 coaches directly employed
- 5473 hours delivered across 23 sports
- 61 registered clients
- 113 scholarships awarded including mentoring programmes
