The course, teachers and accommodation are all approved by the relevant Government Departments. A committee oversees the entire Coláiste Uladh programme and is headed by two well known Gaeltacht course organisers, Seosamh O Gallochóir and Donall O Loinsigh. Ulster GAA Uachtarán, Aogán O Fearghail is course Stiúrthóir/ Administrator.

As our classes cater for the beginner right through to Leaving certificate standard. In the afternoon students participate in informal activities. The primary aim of these activities is to help the students achieve fluency. "Rial na Gaeilge" is enforced in an enlightened, constructive and fair way, with the emphasis on reward and incentive for effort.
