Féile Uladh 2012 Notes:

1. All Hurling Clubs are invited to attend. BUT must be pre-registered before the closing date for applications
2. Clubs may enter as many teams as they wish but players must be allocated to 1 squad list and stay with that team, no matter how each team progresses in the competition.
3. These games are for the benefit of the boys involved. There should be no negative shouting at players or referees
4. Teams must line up on the half way line and shake hands with the opposition after each match
5. We are on a tight time frame and games will be run off as fixture list. If games are missed due to lateness they will not be re-fixed.
6. All teams must be at the venue at least 30mins prior to the first game.

Féile Uladh 2012 Rules:

1. Teams shall be 15-a-side, however, where a team does not have 15 players; games can be played with a lower number of players on each team. There shall be no penalty for the team with the lower number of players.
2. The maximum number of players on each panel shall be 24. There shall be unlimited substitutions in all games.
3. Before commencement of the tournament, all teams must submit the team sheet attached, listing their full panel of players along with their Date of Birth.
4. Players who receive a straight red card will be ineligible for the remainder of the group stage. The duration of any suspension will be decided by the Ulster Feile Disciplinary Committee.
5. Players who receive two yellow cards in a game will receive a red card and will be sent off for the remainder of that game.
6. A player receiving two yellow cards in two games will be ineligible for the remainder of the group stage. The duration of any suspension will be decided by the Ulster Feile Disciplinary Committee.
7. All Group Games on Saturday 28th April -will be 15mins each way with 5min half time break. All Final Games on Saturday 5th May will be 20mins each way and 5min half time break
8. The top team in each group will qualify for their respective Divisional Finals, which will be played on Saturday 5th May 2012 in a venue chosen by the Ulster Feile Committee.
9. Should teams finish on equal points in a group then the result of their match in the group will determine the winner. Should teams still be equal then the team that has conceded the least cumulative scores from all group games shall be deemed to be the winner.
10. Teams will be responsible for providing their own first aid for the event.
11. Teams should encourage their teams to bring a packed lunch as no food or beverages will be provided by the organisers.
